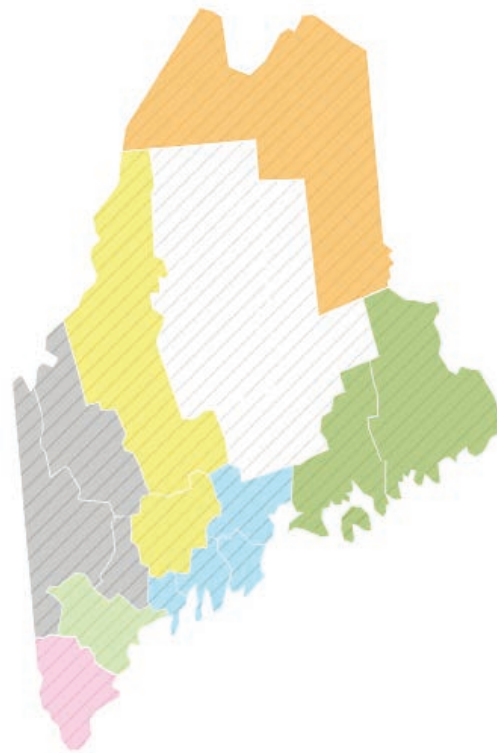

Transportation Tips

- If possible, give as much notice as possible when requesting ride assistance.
- Ask the transportation service about cancer specific funding or grants for medical appointments and let them know if you have MaineCare.

- Never hesitate to reach out to your oncology social worker or patient navigator for additional help.
- Please keep in mind some ride services may have resident, mileage, or trip number limits.

Maine's regional transportation providers may be able to help you get to your cancer-related appointments. Use the map to identify where you live and call the transportation provider in your area. They will do their best to help you navigate available transportation options in your area.
